

Printed Matter & Non-Printed Matter Explained

Printed Matter is zero-rated, meaning it's seen as a duty free product for customs. It must be one of the following formats:

- Books, brochures, pamphlets and leaflets.
- Newspapers, journals or periodicals.
- Children's picture books and painting books.
- Maps, charts and topographical plans.
- Covers, cases and other articles supplied with items 1-5.

Non-Printed Matter is anything else that does not match the above formats.
